Course description

This workshop allows teenagers to discover podcasts as a modern communication tool. They will learn how to use this flexible and accessible format, which allows you to listen to podcasts anytime and anywhere. The workshop focuses on the engagement created by voice and the closeness to the audience. Participants will also explore the diversity of topics covered and the ease of creating a podcast. This workshop also demonstrates how podcasts can be a powerful tool for self-expression and sharing ideas. **A half-day outing will be organized in the BXL1 STUDIO to allow children to become familiar with the behind-the-scenes of production.**
