

Holiday Camp for European School Students

We are pleased to welcome students from the European School to a vibrant holiday camp filled with creativity, movement, and discovery. The program is open to children aged 11 to 15 and runs over several weeks during the summer.

On the registration form, children are asked to select one activity for the morning and another for the afternoon. They may choose the same activity for both sessions, except for Film & Animation and Robotics, which are available only in the afternoon.

We generally recommend selecting two different activities. In our experience, children often find it more engaging and less tiring when their day includes a bit of variety.

Homogeneous, based on level & age. Group size: 4 to 10 children per group.

Activities Offered



Art

In this hands-on workshop, students explore various techniques—from drawing and painting to mixed media—while developing their creativity and personal style.



Manga

For fans of Japanese comics, this activity dives into the world of manga drawing—learning character design, facial expressions, and storytelling through illustration.



Sculpting

Using clay and other materials, participants will bring their ideas to life in three dimensions, discovering the basics of form, texture, and structure.



Multi-sports

Each session is packed with energy and movement, offering a mix of team games and athletic challenges to keep kids active, coordinated, and having fun.



Martial Arts

Focusing on discipline, confidence, and self-control, this introduction to martial arts teaches basic techniques and movements in a supportive environment.



Theater in English

Through playful exercises, improvisation, and short scenes, students will develop confidence and fluency in English while exploring acting and stage presence.



Film & Animation

From storyboarding to filming and basic animation, this workshop lets students work as a team to create their own short movie or animated clip. *Ends at 17:30.*



Cooking

A fun and tasty activity where students learn basic kitchen skills, explore recipes, and prepare simple dishes while practicing teamwork and creativity.



Robotics

Using LEGO Mindstorms kits, students will design, build, and program their own robots. This hands-on activity blends creativity with engineering and problem-solving. *Ends at 17:30.*



Programming

In this computer-based activity, students will learn how to code and create their own simple games or interactive projects using beginner-friendly software. A great way to develop digital literacy and logic skills.



Circus

A playful and dynamic workshop where children can explore juggling, acrobatics, balance, and clowning—encouraging coordination, confidence, and creativity in a lively setting.
